Skills for the Month:

Reading/Literacy: We're reading and writing words and sentences using digraphs /ch/ ck and inflectional ending /ing/.

Math Focus: We are making combinations of 10, when 7, 8, and 9 are addends. We are showing our thinking by drawing number bonds to evaluate and explain our answers to word problems.
